The IASC-ARS 2015 organising committee invites submissions for the 9th conference on “Statistical Computing: Challenges and Opportunities in the Big Data Era”. The conference will be held on the campus of the National University of Singapore on 17-19 December 2015.

This conference will provide a platform for researchers from academia and industry to share their latest findings, exhibit the latest studies and applications, and build up networks with peers in variety areas, including but not limited to, biometrics, econometrics, data analysis, graphics, simulation, algorithms, knowledge-based systems, and Bayesian computing. Presentations may be given on any topic of interest in computational statistics; however, authors are encouraged to submit proposals, papers and posters on, "Statistical Computing: Challenges and Opportunities in the Big Data Era."

The conference will consist of invited talks, submitted papers and contributed posters to be reviewed and selected by a panel of experts in the field. Submitted papers and posters must represent original research. The official language for all submissions is English.

A **Topic-Contributed Session** is planned in advance by one or more organizers and includes 3-4 speakers presenting on a shared topic. Organizers of topic-contributed sessions must submit a one-page proposal including Session title and Session Description with

- Session focus, and appeal
- List of speakers and affiliations
- Tentative title for each presentation. Individual abstracts will be required by April 30, 2015, if the proposed session is approved.
- Session chair and affiliation

Submissions may be made by email to IASC2015@nus.edu.sg. The submission deadline is 15 March 2015. The authors will be notified of the review committee's decision by 15 April 2015.

Contributed Paper/Poster: The submission should include authors' name, affiliation and an abstract limited to 1,200 characters. The abstract should state concisely the methods and results of the paper/poster. Submissions may be made by email to IASC2015@nus.edu.sg. The submission deadline is 15 March 2015. The authors will be notified of the review committee's decision by 15 April 2015.

Poster Presentation - Poster presentations will be arranged during breaks and afternoon sessions. Presenters are able to receive direct and immediate feedback from participants.

Successfully submission will be acknowledged with an electronic receipt including a reference number, which should be quoted in all correspondence. *Once the submission is accepted, all the presenters must register for the conference within 1 week and present the paper at the conference.*
